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FRANCESCO MORELLI GRANT 2025

FIRST SELECTION REPORT

On November 12, 2025, at 2:30 p.m., the Committee of the Francesco Morelli Foundation met at the Foundation's headquarters in Via Amatore Sciesa 4, Milan. The Committee, composed of Maria Teresa Coradduzza, Luca Dal Pozzolo, Carmelo Di Bartolo, Paolo Manera and Luca Prandoni, carried out the first selection of the projects submitted for the Grant, with the support of the team of doctoral researchers Elena Braida, Anna Paola Buonanno, Rooy Charlie Lana and Daniela Santillan.

Projects were assessed on the basis of the following criteria:

- Originality and innovation of the concept
- Feasibility and sustainability of the proposed plan
- Potential social impact

In addition, particular attention was given to the applicants' motivation letters and to the qualitative information provided through the application form.

Also in attendance were the Executive Director of the Foundation, Donatella Pasotto; Giacomo Di Vincenzo, Project Leader of the Francesco Morelli Grant 2025; and Isabella Valli, Head of Administration.

All 77 submitted projects had been shared in advance via the OneDrive platform, together with a summary presentation and the full supporting documentation for each proposal. Following careful review, the Committee selected the following 21 projects to proceed to the next phase:
